Free "Alerts" and more to your mobile phone

Did you know that you can receive "Alerts" to your mobile phone for free? This is very handy to have and will keep you updated on "last minute" changes or reminders to School events. The App is called "Skoolbag" and to install this free App on your iPhone or Android phone, this is what you do:

Simply search for Good Shepherd School Plumpton in the App Store on your phone, PC or Mac and install. After the App is installed on your phone, make sure that you select "OK" to allow Alert notifications. Also click on "more" then "Setup" and select which categories you would like to receive Alerts for.

We strongly encourage our children to read each and every night.



The structure of learning in Year 2 is open and collaborative. Teachers collaborate in programming and delivering lessons that are engaging and challenging targeting your child's learning needs. Children are also expected to collaborate and work together to solve problems and be critical thinkers. With this in mind, teachers determine an appropriate balance between open, collaborative learning and explicit teaching experiences for students to engage with.
