School Life

Schoolwork, homework, assignments, awards, competitions, trophies, do my best, Creative Arts, sporting achievements (This are only examples given.)

Special Interests

Pets, dance, weekends, sport, music

Special Qualities

Kind, caring, helpful, confident, always find time for people, calm, good thinker

Specific skills

Public speaker, good reader, assemblies, liturgies, confidently work with/ speak to large groups

General comment/ Concluding Statement

Confidently meet special visitors to the school, represent the school with confidence, e.g.
