



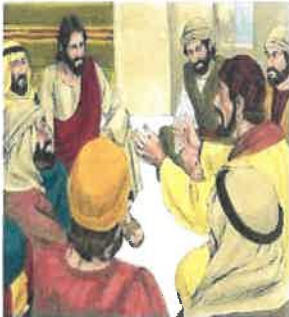

Dear Parents and Guardians,

On Friday this week your child's semester 1 report will be distributed. As a result of Commonwealth Government legislation there are mandatory requirements for all primary school report formats.

As you are aware, reporting the achievements of your child for each Key Learning Area is done using the following Common Grade Scale.

A	The student has extensive (excellent) knowledge and understanding of the content and can readily apply this knowledge. In addition, the student has achieved a very high level of competence in the processes and skills and can apply these skills to new situations.
B	The student has a thorough (high) knowledge and understanding of the content and a high level of competence in the processes and skills. In addition, the student is able to apply this knowledge and these skills in most situations.
C	The student has a sound knowledge and understanding of the main areas of content and has achieved an adequate level of competence in the processes and skills.
D	The student has basic knowledge and understanding of the content and has achieved a limited level of competence in the processes and skills.
E	The student has elementary knowledge and understanding in few areas of the content and has achieved very limited competence in some of the processes and skills.

Levels of achievement label your child's standard of work and not your child as a person. These standards reflect your child's achievements based on assessments during the first half of the year for each Key Learning Area. It is important to read the grade given in conjunction with the effort grading for each Key Learning Area.

Additionally, comparative information showing your child's achievements in all subject areas, relative to all other students in the year level will be available on request.

The general comment at the end of the report gives a general summary of your child's strengths and challenges for the time ahead. Please take time to talk through your child's report with him/her and find an opportunity to affirm, support and encourage him/her in areas of success and achievement.

Just a quick reminder that **ALL student absences need to be explained. This is a legal requirement.**

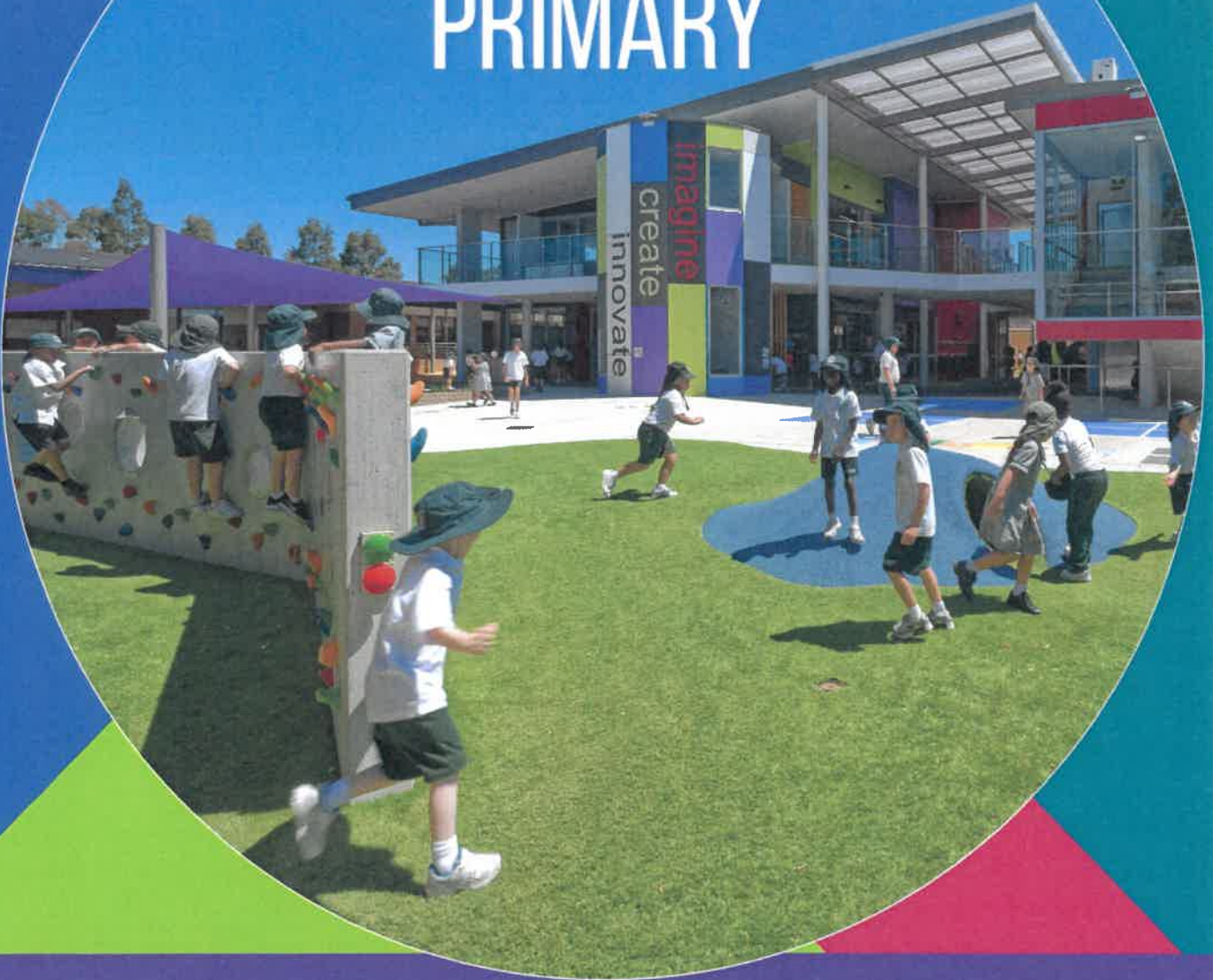
Unexplained Attendance letters

In the event of your child being absent from school due to illness, **please inform the school office by phone or email. It is necessary that a written note of explanation be forwarded to the class teacher on the day of your child's return to school.** We need to receive this note within seven days of the last day of absence. Prolonged absences from school due to illness should be supported by a medical certificate.

ENROLLING NOW FOR KINDY 2023



Good afternoon,

Transport for NSW is upgrading the intersection of Jersey Road and Hyatts Road, Plumpton to improve safety and traffic flow for all road users. The work will involve:

- adjusting the kerb and median on the eastern side of Jersey Road to improve vehicle turning movements
- installing turning arrows on Hyatts Road to allow vehicles to turn right safely and efficiently
- upgrading the pram ramps and traffic light push buttons to assist visually impaired pedestrians
- resurfacing the pavement at the intersection and updating the line marking

This work will take place between Tuesday 14 June and Friday 8 July 2022, weather permitting.

Our work schedule

We will be on site for 12 night shifts between Tuesday 14 June and Friday 8 July, weather permitting. Our work hours will be between 8pm and 5am.

How will the work affect you?

Our work will be carried out at night to lessen the disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers and road users. It may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to limit the disturbance including completing the noisier tasks by midnight, turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use and using noise blankets around our work site when carrying out noisier activities.

The line marking and traffic light cabling installation work is not expected to be noisy.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes and a reduced speed limit of 40 km/h during the night shifts to make sure the work zone is safe. Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times.

Road detours

To improve safety for our workers and motorists, we will need to detour motorists for up to two night shifts during our resurfacing work.

- When asphaltting on the westbound lanes of Jersey Rd, motorists will need to detour via Bottles Rd and Rooty Hill Rd North, or via Pringle Road, Woodstock Avenue and Hyatts Rd.
- When asphaltting on the eastbound lanes of Jersey Rd, motorists will need to detour via Daniels Rd and Shinnick Dr, or via Rooty Hill Rd North and Luxford Rd.
